

KERN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE CCW RENEWAL PROCESS

Renew up to 30 days prior to your CCW Permit expiring

1. Visit www.kernsheriff.org
 - You may renew your CCW on-line at www.kernsheriff.org and click the CCW link. Fill out the form and submit your documents, we will notify you when your CCW is ready for pickup.

Prior to Filling Out the Application:

- Be prepared to scan a copy of your valid California driver's license, which has your current address in Kern County.
- 4 hour Training Certificate, Qualification Card, Marriage Certificate (if spouse's firearm is listed on CCW), and current CCW Permit.

2. Unexpired CCW PERMIT

- **Up to 30 days** prior to your CCW Permit expiring, you may start the process to renew your permit. If your CCW Permit is over 90 days expired, you are required to start the initial process over. By law you cannot carry if your permit is expired.

3. 4HR TRAINING CERTIFICATE from one of our approved firearm vendors.

- The 4HR training certificate is only good for 60 days; therefore, you can only take the course 60 days prior to your CCW permit expiring. No sooner.
- Qualification Card – Must be submitted for every gun listed on your permit.

4. VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE with CURRENT PHYSICAL ADDRESS.

- If you have a change of address, please update it with the DMV first.
- Please obtain a "Brown Card" with the new physical address before you come in to renew.

5. If you would like to add any firearms that are **not** currently on your CCW Permit, please add the information to the on-line system when completing your renewal application.

- All firearms listed on the permit must be registered in California.
